June Lyons Scholarship Class

Every second year, Waverley Patchworkers will hold a workshop by a tutor of note. Admission to this class will be by ballot.

Exhibition

The Waverley Patchworkers' Quilt Show is held every second year, alternating with the Symposium. This is an exhibition of members' work and promotes quilting to the general community. In addition to the quilts on show, a "Shoppers' Mall" is provided by local quilt shops. The members also offer a delightful range of handmade gifts for sale.

Retreat

A weekend of fun and friendship is held annually at various conference venues. Participants enjoy the time and space to work on their own projects.

Waverley Patchworkers Inc. was established in 1981, through the work of a founding member, Dawn Burrows. This was initiated by the Waverley Arts Council. It is a community-based organisation with a membership now over 350.

The group dedicates itself to:

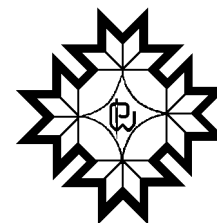
